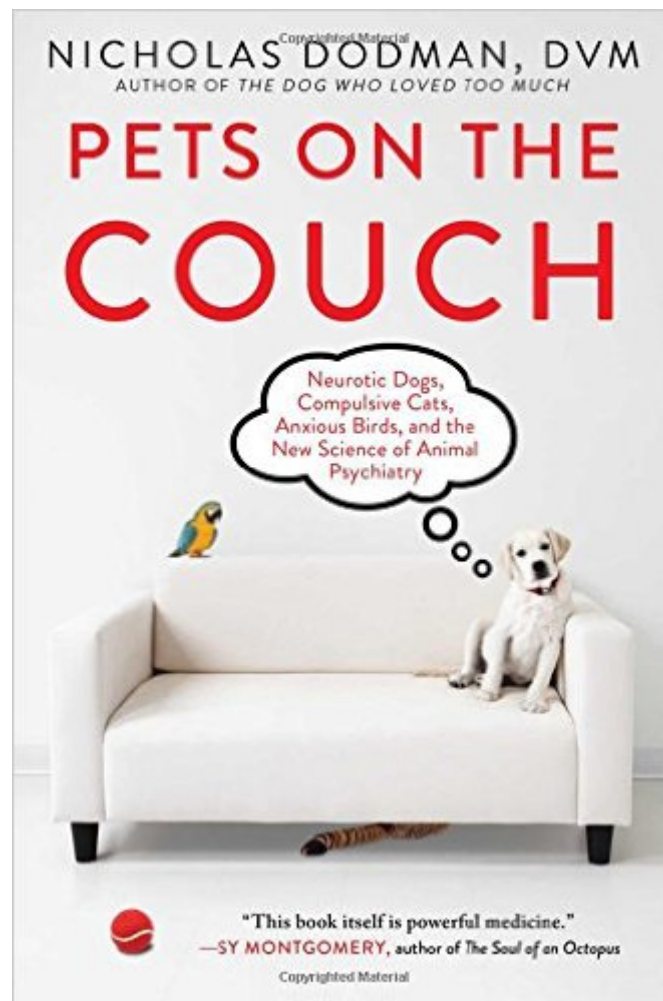

Dr. Nicholas Dodman has written another book that will capture the hearts of pet lovers. He has outdone himself with his new book. This is not a book about "lazy" pets- couch potatoes. This is a

book that explores the many aspects of animal behavior and how emotional problems can be expressed by "unwanted" and difficult behavioral issues and the new medicines that are being used to help animals who are deeply distressed. The book is beautifully written and the author's love for animals and keen desire to help them ring through in every chapter. It is very hard to put this book down in fact. I recommend it highly for animal lovers who are interested in "One Medicine" to which the author subscribes. We are not that different than our companion animals- emotionally or physically- It is a must read.

I've known this author for years, as a lecturer, media personality, and colleague. I have a sacred space on my shelf for all his books. *Pets on the Couch*--is by far and away my favorite. It dares to cross the line, as I do in my book *Modern Dog Parenting* (a book reviewed by Dr. Dodman), to regard dogs and many other domestic animals in the same light as children. They are vulnerable to abuse, neglect, and suffering. Many of the conditions we complain about are ones we have unwittingly created. He empathizes with our pets while empathizing with the loving pet owner as welcome. He ends each story example by outlining solutions and therapies to calm those on both ends of the leash.
